SINGLE LANE CLOSURES ON WATER STREET BRIDGE TO BEGIN TUESDAY, SEPT. 2

The City of Milwaukee is rehabilitating the Water Street Bridge over the Milwaukee River.

Beginning Tuesday, September 2 at 6 a.m., traffic over the Water Street Bridge will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction as nonpainting, structural work begins.

The single lane closures will turn into a full closure of the Water Street Bridge to all traffic beginning Monday, September 8 at 6 a.m. Traffic will be detoured as shown at right.



Below is an estimated schedule of work for the project and the associated impacts to bridge traffic. Schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.

Week of September 8 - Week of September 29

First bridge bascule leaf painted. Approach work to occur on the opposite side.

Bridge closed and traffic detoured *

Week of October 6 - Week of October 27


Second bridge bascule leaf painted. Approach work to occur on the opposite side.


Bridge closed and traffic detoured *

Week of November 3 - Week of November 10

Final items (pavement marking, project cleanup, etc) Bridge open to 1 lane of traffic in each direction
