About the Project

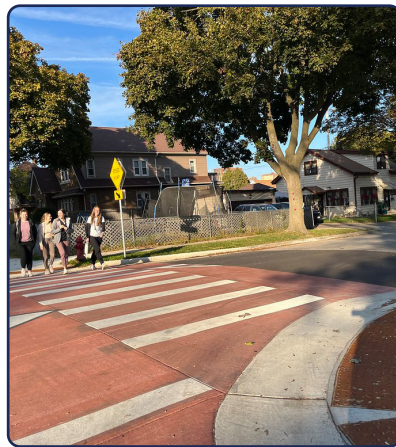
The City of Milwaukee, in partnership with the Brady Street Business Improvement District (BID), is making improvements to E. Brady Street between N. Farwell Avenue to N. Van Buren Street to reduce speeding and make the street safer for people walking, driving, and visiting.

Improvements Include

- Installing **pinned-on bumpouts** at the intersections of Cass Street and Humboldt Avenue to reduce passing on the right and illegal parking, and make it easier for people to cross the street
- Installing **raised crosswalks** at the intersections of Marshall Street, Franklin Place, and Arlington Place to reduce speeding, increase the visibility of people walking, and make it easier for people to cross the street

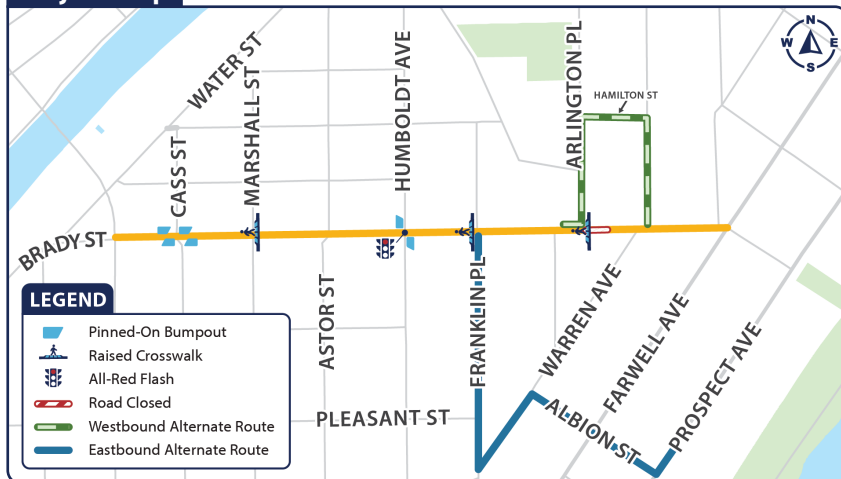


Pinned-on bumpout

* The traffic signal at Humboldt Avenue will remain in an all-red flashing phase during and after construction in order for the project team to evaluate the effectiveness of the signal with the new traffic calming measures.

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Construction Impacts & Schedule

Construction for the project is anticipated to begin the week of September 28 and be completed by the end of October. To accommodate the Brady Street Pet Parade, work west of Humboldt Avenue will not begin until the week of October 5.



During construction, the intersections of Marshall Street and Franklin Place will be open to one lane of traffic in each direction, as crosswalks are constructed in halves. The **intersection of Arlington Place will be closed to traffic**, as the street is too narrow to provide two-way access. Please see map at left for details.



On-street parking will not be allowed near the (5) intersections being worked on; follow all posted signs.



MCTS will detour the Green Line to accommodate the closure at Arlington Place. See the Umo app for details.
